

Rosa's Spanish Clock Shop

Learning objective: To tell the time in Spanish using 'es la' for one o'clock and 'son las' for other hours.

Rosa the parrot is helping her friends learn how to tell the time in Spanish. Follow the instructions to draw the clocks and label them with the correct Spanish phrases.

Draw: Draw four large, friendly-looking circular clocks arranged in a square on your page. Each clock should have clear hands pointing to the times mentioned in the questions.
Style: Clean lines, colourful clock faces with clear numbers 1 to 12. Add a small illustration of Rosa the parrot wearing a colourful scarf in the corner of the page, cheering the children on.

Label words: Es la una · Son las dos · Son las cinco · Son las diez · y cuarto · y media

Steps:

1. Draw a clock showing 1:00. Write the Spanish phrase underneath.
2. Draw a clock showing 2:30. Label the time in Spanish.
3. What Spanish phrase would you use for 5:15? Write it below.
4. If a clock shows 10:00, why do we use 'Son las' instead of 'Es la'?
5. Draw a clock showing 10:15. Write the correct Spanish label next to it.
