Learning objective: To be able to tell the time in Spanish using 'es la' and 'son las' for hours, and basic minute vocabulary.

Help Rosa the Parrot get ready for her day! Read the questions carefully and choose the correct Spanish time phrases. Remember: use 'es la una' for one o'clock and 'son las' for all other hours.

9. 9. Write the Spanish for 1:00. (1 mark)

10. 10. What do we add to a time to say it is exactly 'o'clock'? (1 mark)
