

Rosa's Travel Adventure: Spanish Transport Sorting

Learning objective: To learn and categorise Spanish vocabulary for different modes of transport.

Rosa the parrot is preparing for a journey across Spain! Help her organise her travel plans by matching the Spanish transport words to their correct English meanings. Once you have matched them, sort the words into the correct category: 'On the ground' or 'In the air'.

Word bank: el coche (car) · el tren (train) · el avión (aeroplane) · el barco (boat) · la bicicleta (bicycle) · el helicóptero (helicopter)

1. Write the Spanish word for 'the car' and 'the bicycle' next to the correct English translation. (2 marks)

2. Which of the words in the word bank would you use to travel across the sea? Write the Spanish word. (1 mark)

3. Rosa wants to fly. List two Spanish words from the bank that describe transport that travels in the air. (2 marks)

4. If a train ticket costs £12 and a bus ticket costs £4, what is the total cost for both in pounds? (1 mark)

5. Why might someone choose 'la bicicleta' instead of 'el coche' for a short journey? Write one reason. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Rosa the parrot sitting on top of her favourite mode of transport. Label your drawing using the correct Spanish word from the word bank.



Extension challenge: Choose one mode of transport and write a sentence in Spanish about it, such as 'El tren es rápido' (The train is fast).
