

¡Vamos! - Transport in Spanish

Jump on board and travel through Spanish vocabulary with Rosa the parrot!

- To talk about how you travel, use the word 'Voy' followed by 'en' and then your mode of transport, like 'Voy en bicicleta'.
- For transport that travels on water, such as a boat, we use the word 'El barco'.
- If you are travelling through the sky in a plane, you would use the Spanish term 'El avión'.
- When travelling on land by bus, remember to use the phrase 'El autobús' in your sentences.
- Practise your pronunciation: 'El coche' is a classic way to travel on the road in Spain.

Did you know? Did you know? In Spain, the high-speed train network is called the 'AVE'. It is one of the fastest ways to travel across the country, reaching speeds of up to 300 kilometres per hour! If you want to say 'I go by train', you say 'Voy en tren'.
