Learning objective: To recognise and use common Spanish verbs in the present tense (first and third person singular).

6. Which verb means 'to live'? A) Comer B) Vivir* C) Hablar D) Beber (1 mark)

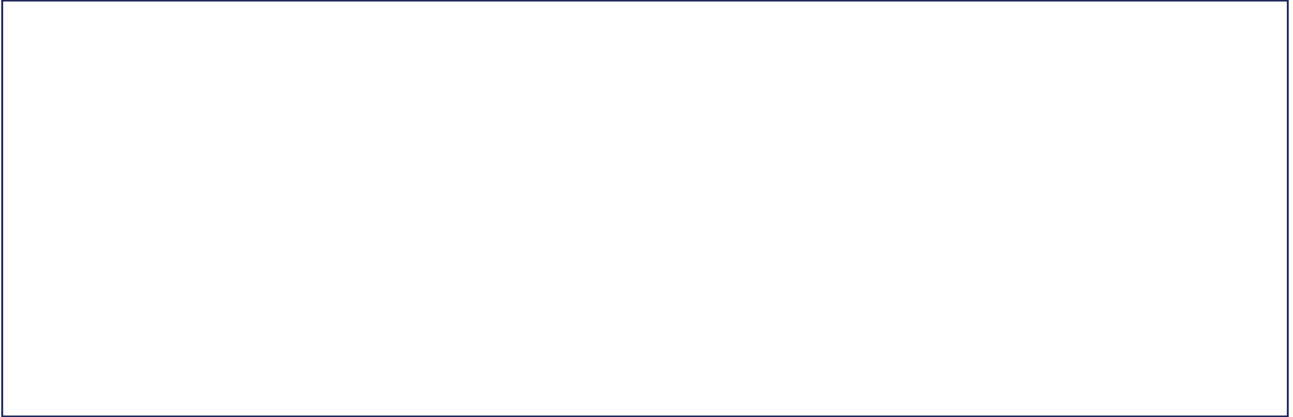
7. True or False: 'Ella' means 'she'. (1 mark)
