

Rosa's Weather Diary: Mi Diario del Tiempo

Learning objective: To use Spanish vocabulary to describe the weather and record observations over a week.

Rosa the parrot wants to know what the weather is like where you live! Use the word bank to fill in your weather diary. For each day, write a sentence in Spanish describing the weather, and then explain why that weather is good or bad for your favourite outdoor activity.

Word bank: Hace sol (It is sunny) · Hace frío (It is cold) · Hace calor (It is hot) · Está nublado (It is cloudy) · Llueve (It is raining) · Nieva (It is snowing) · Me gusta (I like) · No me gusta (I do not like)

1. Lunes (Monday): Describe the weather today and how it makes you feel. (2 marks)

2. Martes (Tuesday): Describe the weather today and tell me if you can play outside. (2 marks)

3. Miércoles (Wednesday): If it is raining (Llueve), what do you need to wear? (2 marks)

4. Jueves (Thursday): Choose a weather type and write a full sentence in Spanish about it. (2 marks)

5. Viernes (Friday): Rosa loves the sun. Describe the weather today using the word 'sol'. (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Imagine you are a weather reporter for the school news. Write a short paragraph in Spanish predicting the weather for the weekend. Will it be sunny or rainy?
