Explore the Spectrum: Let your creativity shine with Zara the Zebra!

- **Primary colors** are the base colors that cannot be made by mixing others: Red, Yellow, and Blue.
- **Secondary colors** are created by mixing two primary colors together, such as Green, Orange, and Purple.
- A **tint** is created by adding white to a color to make it lighter, while a **shade** is created by adding black to make it darker.
- **Warm colors** sit on one side of the color wheel, reminding us of sunlight and fire, while **cool colors** remind us of water and plants.
- The **color wheel** is a circular diagram that shows how different colors relate to one another.

Did you know? Did you know? Even though Zara is black and white, she loves using the color wheel to imagine the world in bright, vivid patterns! Scientists have discovered that colors can change how we feel—warm colors like red and yellow can make a room feel cosy, while cool colors like blue and green can make us feel calm.
