

Conjunctions - Joining Words

Learning objective: To understand and use conjunctions such as and, but, or in sentences accurately.

This worksheet will help you practice using conjunctions to join words and phrases. Use the word bank to complete the sentences.

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Word bank: and · but · or

1. Max the monkey is trying to decide what to eat for his snack. He likes apples _ bananas. Which conjunction should he use? (2 marks)

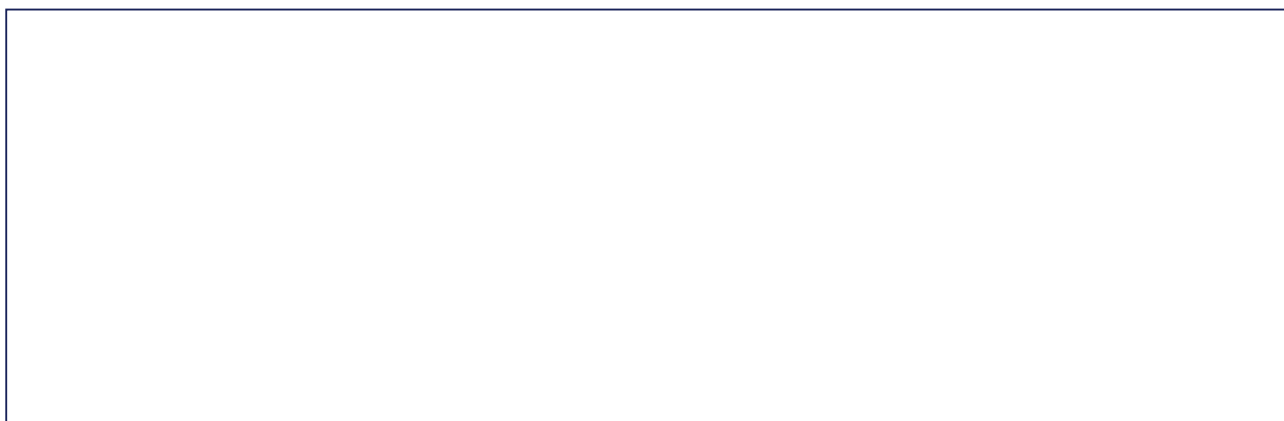
2. Ellie the elephant is having a picnic and she doesn't want rain _ sunshine. Which conjunction fits here? (2 marks)

3. Leo the lion is going to the zoo _ the park. He can't decide. Which conjunction should he use? (2 marks)

4. Use the conjunction 'or' to complete the sentence: 'Finn the dolphin wants to go swimming _ eating fish.' (2 marks)

5. Zara the zebra likes to draw _ paint. Which conjunction fits here? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Max making a decision about his snack and include the conjunction you used in the sentence.



Extension challenge: In your notebook, write three sentences using different conjunctions. Try to use 'and', 'but', and 'or' in different ways.
