

Crafting Vivid Descriptions with Max and Zara

Learning objective: To use expanded noun phrases and adventurous adjectives to create vivid imagery in creative writing.

Read each question carefully. Use your imagination to expand your sentences, making sure to include exciting adjectives and precise nouns to help the reader picture your story.

Max the monkey and Zara the zebra are heading on an expedition to the Crystal Cavern. They need your help to describe the sights, sounds, and feelings of their journey.

Word bank: shimmering · ancient · mysterious · vibrant · enormous · tranquil · magnificent · colossal

1. Max finds a hidden treasure chest. Instead of saying 'He found a box', write an expanded noun phrase to describe the object. Use at least two adjectives. (2 marks)

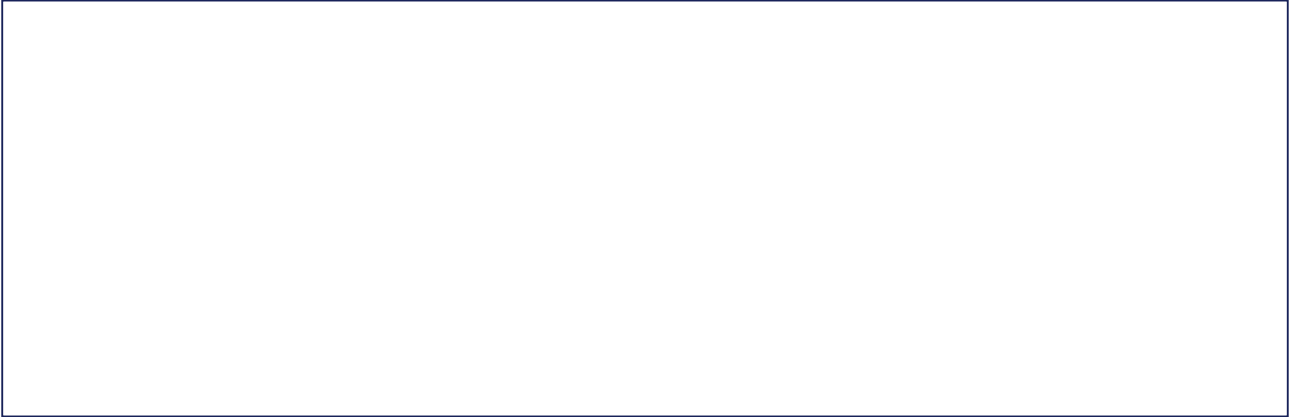
2. Zara is looking at the walls of the cavern. Describe the rocks using a simile. (Example: The rocks sparkled like...) (2 marks)

3. Write a sentence describing the sound inside the cavern. Remember to use an adverb to describe how the sound travels (e.g., quietly, echoes loudly). (2 marks)

4. Max and Zara feel excited. Replace the word 'excited' with two more ambitious adjectives to describe their emotions. (2 marks)

5. Combine these two simple sentences into one complex sentence using a conjunction (e.g., although, because, while): 'The cavern was dark. Zara used her patterns to light the way.' (2 marks)

Draw: Draw the Crystal Cavern as Max and Zara see it. Include at least three things you described in your answers, such as the shimmering chest or the glowing walls.



Extension challenge: Write a short paragraph (3-4 sentences) explaining what Max and Zara find inside the chest. Try to use personification (e.g., the gold coins danced in the light).
