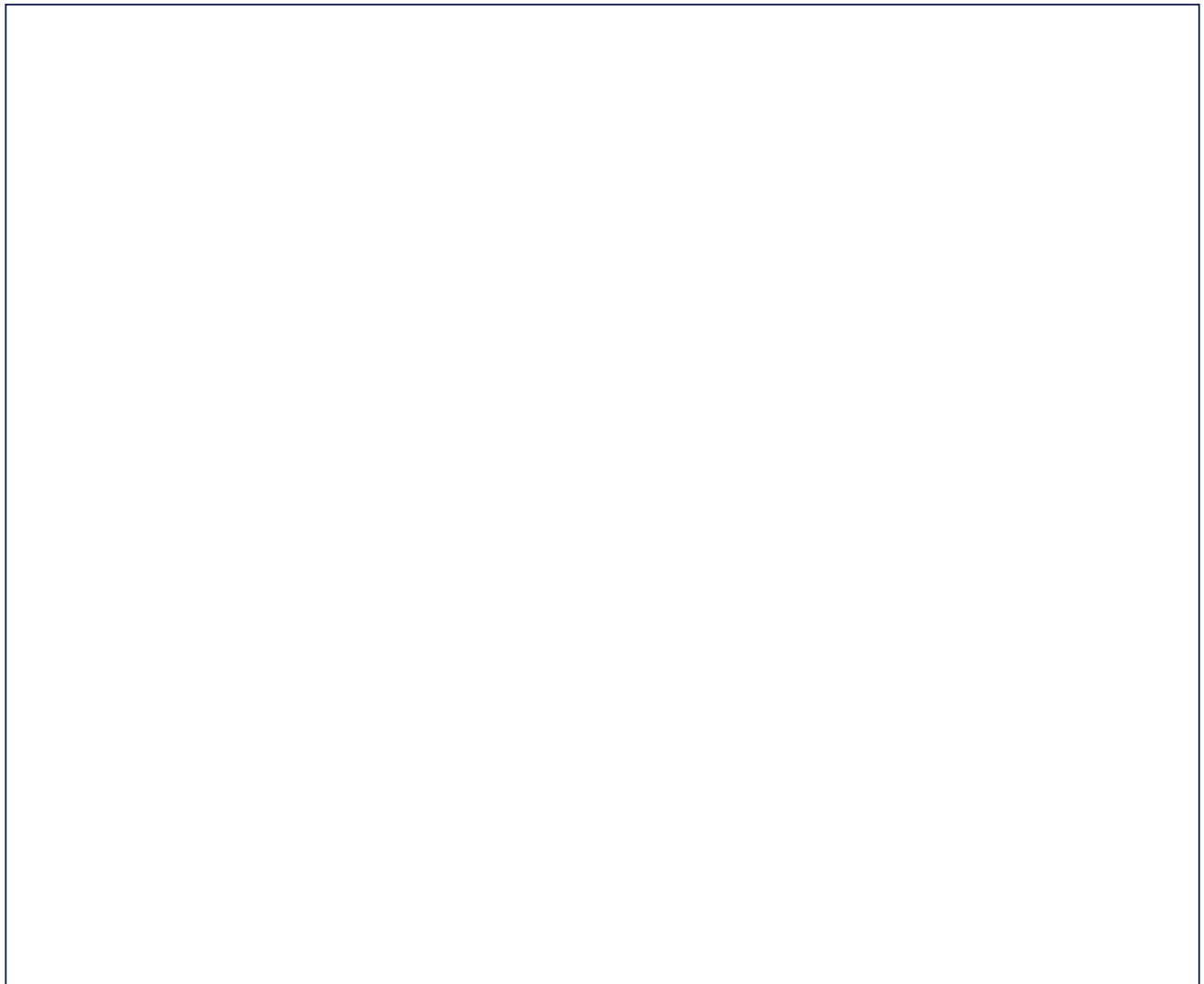


Diwali Festival of Lights

Learning objective: To understand the significance of Diwali, the festival of lights, and to create a visual representation of the celebration.

Follow the step-by-step instructions to complete your drawing of a Diwali festival scene. Use the word bank to add labels and details to your drawing.

Draw: Step 1: Draw a big tree in the background. Step 2: Around the tree, draw many small twinkling lights and lanterns hanging from the branches. Step 3: In the foreground, draw a few circles made of colorful powder or 'Rangoli'. Step 4: Add some pumpkins, candies, and sweets to the scene. Step 5: Draw some people with their hands folded in a prayerful gesture, offering respect to the deities. Step 6: Draw a few fireworks in the sky, spreading a lot of colors. Step 7: Add the word 'Diwali' at the top of your drawing. Remember to use the word bank to label important parts of your drawing.
