

Expanded Noun Phrase Adventure with Max and Zara

Learning objective: To identify and use expanded noun phrases to add detail and description to writing.

Read the sentences carefully and help Max the monkey and Zara the zebra improve their descriptions! Remember, an expanded noun phrase adds extra detail to a noun using adjectives or prepositional phrases.
