

Max the Monkey's Market Math Mystery

Learning objective: To develop reading comprehension skills by identifying facts, interpreting character feelings, and inferring meaning from a short narrative.

Read the story below carefully, then answer the 10 questions that follow. Good luck!

The village market was bustling. Max the monkey hopped from one wooden stall to the next, clutching his shopping list. He was looking for fresh fruit for his fruit salad.
