

Rosa's Animal Art Studio

Learning objective: To identify and spell common animal names in French and present them accurately in a creative drawing.

Rosa the parrot wants to create a colorful mural of her animal friends. Use the word bank to label the animals in your drawing. Make sure your illustrations are clear and include the correct French label next to each one.

Draw: Create a vibrant, colorful nature scene on your paper. In the center, draw a large tree for 'l'oiseau' to sit in. Near the base of the tree, draw 'le chien' and 'le chat' playing together. Add a small pond or bowl nearby for 'le poisson' and a grassy patch for 'le lapin' and 'le cheval'. Use bright colors for the animals and ensure each animal is clearly labelled with the correct French term from the word bank.



Label words: le chien (dog) · le chat (cat) · le lapin (rabbit) · l'oiseau (bird) · le poisson (fish) · le cheval (horse)

Steps:

1. Draw a scene featuring at least four of the animals from the word bank. Label each animal using its French name.
2. Which animal from the word bank is 'le poisson'? Write the English meaning.
3. What is the French word for 'the cat'?

4. If you wanted to add a 'hamster' to your drawing, it is 'le hamster'. Can you draw a small hamster in the corner and label it?
5. Explain why it is important to include the correct article (le or l') when labelling your animals.
