

Rosa's Rainbow Art Gallery

Learning objective: To identify, spell, and use French colors to describe objects and express personal preferences.

Rosa the parrot wants to help you create your own French art exhibition! Look at the word bank for help with your spellings. Follow the instructions in each section to complete your gallery guide in French.

Word bank: rouge (red) · bleu (blue) · jaune (yellow) · vert (green) · orange (orange) · violet (purple) · rose (pink) · noir (black) · blanc (white) · C'est... (It is...) · J'aime... (I like...) · Je n'aime pas... (I do not like...)

1. My Favorite Color: Write a sentence in French explaining which color is your favorite and why. (2 marks)

2. The Artist's Palette: List three objects you see in your classroom and describe their color in French (e.g., Le livre est rouge). (3 marks)

3. Color Mixing: If you mix 'jaune' and 'bleu', what color do you get? Write the name of the new color in French. (1 mark)

4. Disliked Colors: Write a sentence in French explaining which color you do not like and name one thing that is usually that color. (2 marks)

5. The Rainbow Challenge: Can you name four colors from the rainbow in French? (4 marks)

Extension challenge: Imagine you are painting a portrait of Rosa the parrot. Write three sentences in French describing the colors you would use for her feathers and her beak.
