

Grade 3 French Assessment: Ma Famille (My Family)

Learning objective: To identify, write, and use vocabulary related to family members and possessive adjectives in French.

Read each question carefully. Write your answers clearly in the spaces provided. You have 30 minutes to complete this assessment.

Rosa the parrot is showing her friends her family tree. She says: 'Voici ma famille! Voici mon père et ma mère. Voici mon frère et ma sœur. J'aime beaucoup ma famille.'

Word bank: la mère · le père · le frère · la sœur · le grand-père · la grand-mère · mon · ma · mes

1. Translate the following words into English: 1) le père, 2) la sœur. (2 marks)

2. If you want to say 'my mother', which possessive adjective do you use: mon, ma, or mes? Explain why. (3 marks)

3. Translate this sentence into French: 'This is my brother.' (3 marks)

4. Match the French word to the English meaning: 1) le grand-père (A: Grandmother), 2) la grand-mère (B: Grandfather). (2 marks)

5. Rosa has two brothers. How would you write 'my brothers' in French using the correct possessive adjective? (3 marks)

6. Look at the list of family members. Write three full sentences in French describing your own family (e.g., 'Voici mon père...'). (7 marks)

7. Why do we use 'ma' for 'mère' but 'mon' for 'père'? Describe the rule regarding gender in French. (5 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of a family tree. Label at least four members of the family using the correct French nouns (e.g., 'le père', 'la sœur').



Extension challenge: Write a short paragraph (4-5 sentences) in French describing who lives in your house using family vocabulary and the verb 'habiter' (to live). Total: /25
