

Rosa's French Market Diary

Learning objective: To use French vocabulary for shopping, prices, and food items within the context of a market visit.

Rosa the parrot is helping her friends store at a French market! Imagine you are visiting the market with her. Use the vocabulary provided to complete your market diary entry. Remember to use £ for your prices and include the correct French terms for the items you have 'bought'.

Word bank: le pain (bread) · la pomme (apple) · le fromage (cheese) · le chocolat (chocolate) · Combien ça coûte? (How much does it cost?) · Ça coûte... · S'il vous plaît (Please) · Merci (Thank you)

1. Market Greeting: Write a sentence in French to greet the market stall owner politely. (2 marks)

2. Shopping List: List three items you are buying today. Use the French nouns and the English translation. (3 marks)

3. Asking the Price: Write the French question you would ask the stall owner to find out how much an item costs. (2 marks)

4. The Total: Write down the price of one of your items using pounds (£). For example: 'Le pain coûte £1.50'. (2 marks)

5. Polite Closing: Write a sentence to thank the stall owner in French before you leave. (1 mark)

Extension challenge: Can you add up the total cost of two items you bought and write the final amount in a full sentence using French numbers?
