

Rosa's French Time Diary

Learning objective: To tell the time in French using o'clock, half past, and quarter past/to.

Rosa the parrot wants to know how you spend your day! Use your knowledge of French time phrases to complete your daily schedule. Remember to use 'Il est...' to start your sentences.

Word bank: Il est... (It is...) · une heure (one o'clock) · deux heures (two o'clock) · et quart (quarter past) · et demie (half past) · moins le quart (quarter to) · le matin (in the morning) · l'après-midi (in the afternoon)

1. Morning Routine: Write the time you wake up in French and what you do. (2 marks)

2. School Lunch: Write the time you eat lunch in French using 'et demie'. (2 marks)

3. Afternoon Play: Write a time using 'et quart' to describe when you play outside. (2 marks)

4. Evening Reading: Write a time using 'moins le quart' for when you read a book with Pip. (2 marks)

5. Challenge: Write a full sentence in French explaining why you like a specific time of day. (3 marks)

Extension challenge: Can you draw four clocks showing these times and label them in French for Rosa?
