

Rosa's Weather Journal: Le Temps

Learning objective: To identify and use French vocabulary to describe different types of weather.

Use the word bank to label the weather scenes in your drawing. Make sure your labels are written clearly in French next to the correct weather feature.

Draw: Draw a large landscape divided into four sections, like a comic book page. In each section, illustrate a different weather scene: a bright sunny day, a rainy day, a windy day with trees blowing, and a snowy day. Add Rosa the parrot flying across the top of the page. Use bright colors and clear, bold lines.



Label words: Il fait beau (It is beautiful/sunny) · Il pleut (It is raining) · Il fait du vent (It is windy) · Il neige (It is snowing) · Il fait froid (It is cold) · Il fait chaud (It is hot)

Steps:

1. Rosa the parrot is flying over four different regions. Draw a sun in the first corner and label it with the correct French phrase.
2. In the second corner, draw a cloud with raindrops. Label this scene using the correct French phrase from the word bank.
3. Draw a small snowman in the third corner. Which French phrase describes this weather? Write it below.
4. If it is a very windy day, which phrase from the word bank would you use? Write it here.

5. Look at your completed drawing. Choose one scene and write a full sentence in French explaining how it feels to be there (e.g., 'Il fait chaud et il fait beau').
