

Finn's Biome Explorer Fact-File

Learning objective: To identify and describe the characteristics of different biomes, including climate, plants, and animals.

Finn the dolphin is traveling the world to map different biomes! Choose one biome (such as the tropical rainforest, hot desert, or tundra) and complete this fact-file to help Finn record his discoveries.

Word bank: climate · precipitation · habitat · adaptation · temperature · equator · vegetation · ecosystem

1. Biome Name and Location: Which biome have you chosen and where in the world is it usually found? (2 marks)

2. Climate and Weather: Describe the temperature and rainfall of this biome. Is it hot, cold, wet, or dry? (3 marks)

3. Plant Life: Which plants grow here? Explain how they survive in this specific environment. (3 marks)

4. Animal Adaptations: Name an animal that lives here. What special features does it have to help it survive? (3 marks)

5. Environmental Challenges: What is one thing that might threaten this biome or the animals living in it? (2 marks)

6. Finn's Summary: If Finn visited this biome, what is the most surprising thing he would see? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Can you compare your chosen biome to a different one? Write two sentences explaining one way they are similar and one way they are different.
