

Drawing Earthquakes with Pip and Finn

Learning objective: To understand the concept of earthquakes and their effects on the Earth's surface.

Imagine Pip the bookworm and Finn the dolphin exploring a city after a recent earthquake.

Draw: Draw a scenic city with Pip and Finn walking down the street. Include at least three buildings or structures that have been damaged by the earthquake. Don't forget to add a fault line and a 'Help' sign.



Label words: Earthquake · Tsunami · Volcano · Fault Line · Cracked Pavement · Help Sign · Pillar

Steps:

1. Draw a picture of Pip and Finn walking through the city after the earthquake. What do you see?
2. Label the different buildings and structures in the city that have been damaged by the earthquake.
3. Show the path of the fault line that caused the earthquake by drawing a zig-zag line through the city.
4. Draw a sign that says 'Help' in the city. What does it mean to you?
5. Illustrate what you think a tsunami might look like if it were to hit the city. Remember, a tsunami is a very large wave.
