

Addition Assessment for Grade 3

Learning objective: To test and reinforce the ability to add numbers up to four digits with and without regrouping.

Answer the following questions. Show all your working clearly. Use a ruler for straight lines and keep your work neat.

Word bank: addition · digits · regrouping · sum · carry over · thousands · hundreds · tens · units

1. Add 345 and 278. Show your working. (2 marks)

2. Add 1,234 and 567. What is the sum? (1 mark)

3. Add 678 and 321. Show any regrouping that happens. (2 marks)

4. Add 4,567 and 890. What is the sum? (1 mark)

5. If Zara has 345 marbles and she gets 278 more, how many marbles does she have in total? Show your working. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a number line to show how you would add 345 and 278. Label the number line clearly.
