1. Calculate $567 - 248$. Show your working. (2 marks)

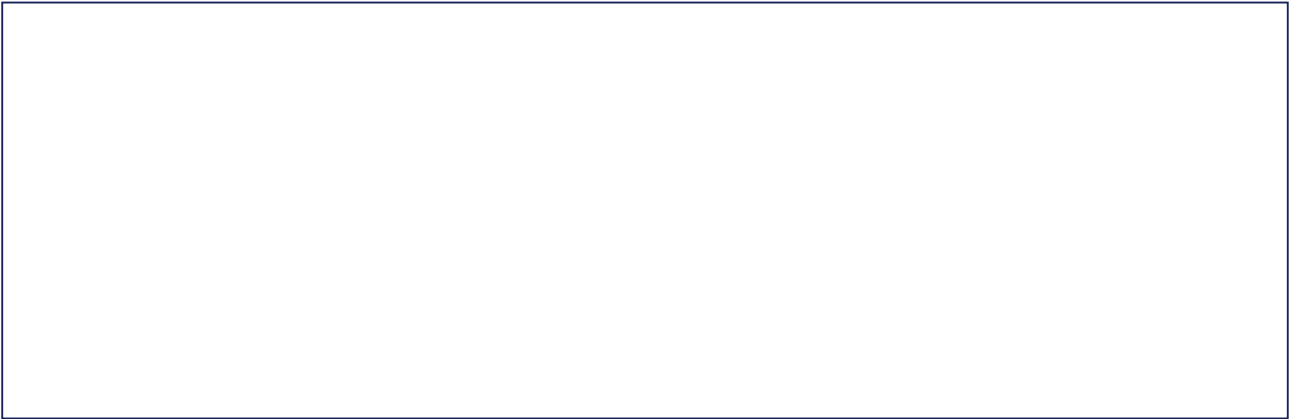
2. Find the difference between 890 and 356. Write down the process you used. (2 marks)

3. There are 723 apples in a crate. If 456 apples are taken out, how many are left? Show your working. (2 marks)

4. A farmer has 600 meters of fencing. She uses 322 meters to surround a field. How much fencing does she have left? Explain your answer. (2 marks)

5. In a race, runner A finished the race in 2 hours and 45 minutes, while runner B finished in 2 hours and 58 minutes. How much faster was runner A? Convert your answer into minutes. (2 marks)
