3. Which safety equipment is usually found at the side of a swimming pool? (1 mark)

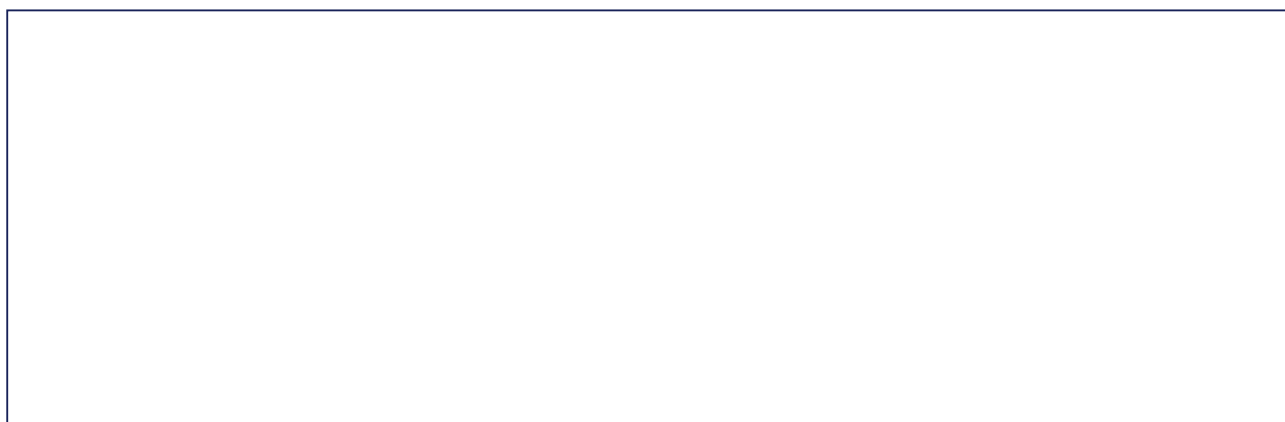
4. What do you do when you want to swim fast? (1 mark)
