- Your personal information, such as your full name, home address, and school name, should always be kept private to keep you safe.
- A strong password acts like a secret key. Never share your password with anyone except your trusted parents or carers.
- If you see something online that makes you feel uncomfortable, worried, or sad, always tell a trusted adult straight away.
- Treat others with the same kindness online as you do in the classroom; think before you type to ensure your words are helpful and polite.
- Not everything you read online is true. Always check with an adult if you are unsure about information you have found.
