

Symbols and Traditions of Judaism

Learning objective: To identify and illustrate key symbols and objects used in Jewish faith and traditions.

Max the monkey is helping us explore the beautiful symbols of Judaism! Use the word bank to label your drawings and follow the steps to create your own religious display sheet.

Draw: Create a colorful collage page. In the center, draw a building representing a Synagogue. Around the building, draw the six items mentioned in the steps (the Star of David, Menorah, Torah, Challah, Kippah, and the building itself). Use bright colors and ensure each item is clearly labelled with a word from the word bank.



Label words: Star of David · Menorah · Torah · Challah · Kippah · Synagogue

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a Star of David (a six-pointed star). Now, label it using the word bank.
2. Step 2: Draw a Menorah (a candle holder). Can you label this and color the candles yellow?
3. Step 3: Draw a Torah scroll (the holy book) with its wooden rollers.
4. Step 4: Draw a braided loaf of Challah bread used for the Sabbath.
5. Step 5: Draw a Kippah (a small skullcap) and label it.
6. Step 6: In the center of your page, draw a Synagogue (the Jewish place of worship).
