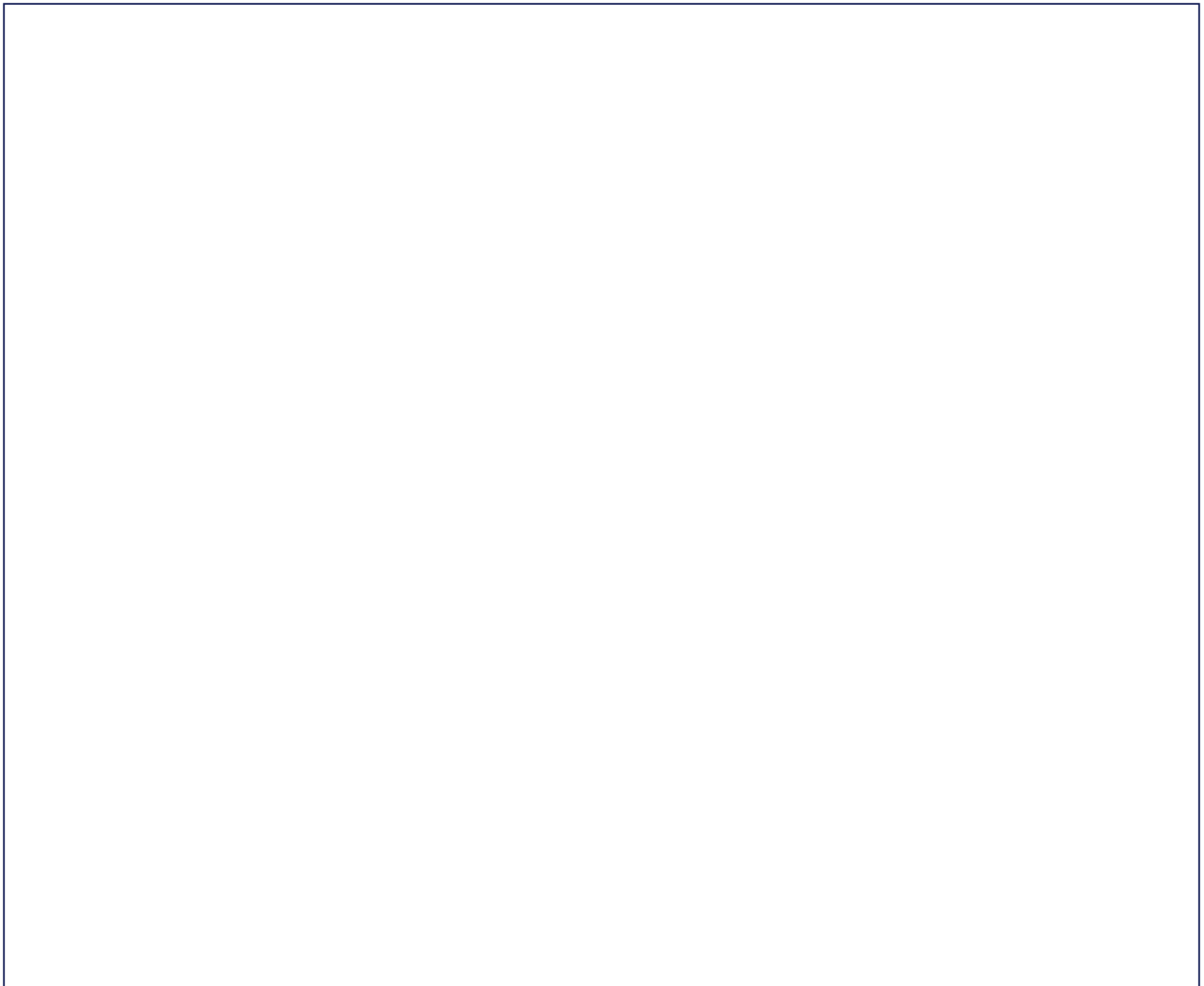


Rosa's Spanish Wardrobe

Learning objective: To identify and use vocabulary for common items of clothing in Spanish.

Help Rosa the parrot get ready for her travels! Follow the drawing instructions below and use the Spanish labels from the word bank to complete your scene.

Draw: Draw a large, friendly parrot standing in the center of the page. Around the parrot, draw the following items: a t-shirt (la camiseta), a pair of pants (los pantalones), a hat (el sombrero), a jacket (la chaqueta), and a dress (el vestido). Once you have drawn the items, label each one using the correct Spanish term from the word bank. Make your drawing colorful and bright!



Label words: la camiseta (t-shirt) · los pantalones (pants) · el sombrero (hat) · los zapatos (shoes) · la chaqueta (jacket) · el vestido (dress)

Steps:

1. Rosa is going to a sunny park. Which two items from the word bank should she wear to stay cool? Write them in Spanish.
2. If it starts to rain, which item would you draw for Rosa to wear to keep warm? Write the Spanish word.
3. Translate the phrase 'the hat' into Spanish using the word bank.
4. Draw a small pair of 'zapatos' near Rosa's feet in your picture.

5. Why do we use 'los' before 'pantalones' but 'la' before 'camiseta'? (Hint: Think about singular and plural).
