

Rosa's Wardrobe Fact-File: Mi Ropa

Learning objective: To identify and describe items of clothing in Spanish, using appropriate vocabulary and colors.

Help Rosa the parrot organize her colorful wardrobe! Use the word bank to fill in the sections below. Describe what you are wearing today or create a stylish outfit for a friend. Remember to use the correct Spanish words for clothing and colors.

Word bank: la camiseta (t-shirt) · los pantalones (pants) · el jersey (sweater) · los zapatos (shoes) · el vestido (dress) · rojo/a (red) · azul (blue) · amarillo/a (yellow) · verde (green) · es (is) · son (are)

1. Mi ropa favorita (My favorite clothes): Describe one item of clothing you like to wear. Include the Spanish name and the color. (2 marks)

2. El conjunto de Rosa (Rosa's outfit): Write a sentence in Spanish describing an outfit for Rosa. Example: 'El jersey es rojo.' (2 marks)

3. Comparación (Comparison): List two items of clothing you might wear in winter and two you might wear in summer using Spanish vocabulary. (4 marks)

4. Traducción (Translation): Explain in your own words why it is important to know the gender (masculine or feminine) of the clothing word when choosing a color. (3 marks)

5. Desafío creativo (Creative challenge): If you were designing a new outfit for a parrot, what would it look like? Describe it using at least three Spanish adjectives. (4 marks)

Extension challenge: Can you write a short dialogue between two people in Spanish about what they are wearing? Use '¿Qué llevas?' (What are you wearing?) to start the conversation.
