

Rosa's Spanish Weekly Adventure: Assessment

Learning objective: To recall and apply knowledge of the days of the week in Spanish.

Read each question carefully. Rosa the parrot is here to help you remember your new vocabulary! Write your answers clearly in English or Spanish as requested.

Rosa the parrot has a very busy week. On lunes she practices her songs. On martes she reads a book. On miércoles she flies to the park. On jueves she helps Max with his math. On viernes she paints with Zara. On sábado she visits her friends, and on domingo she rests in her nest.

Word bank: lunes · martes · miércoles · jueves · viernes · sábado · domingo · Hoy es... · Mañana es...

1. Using the passage, write the Spanish word for Monday and the Spanish word for Sunday. (2 marks)

2. If today is 'lunes', what is the Spanish word for tomorrow ('mañana')? (2 marks)

3. List the days of the week in Spanish in the correct order, starting with Monday. (7 marks)

4. Rosa says, 'Miércoles is my favorite day.' Explain why Rosa might find it hard to spell 'miércoles' compared to the other days. (4 marks)

5. Rosa is planning a party. She wants to invite her friends on a day that is not a school day (the weekend). Which two days could she choose? Write them in Spanish and explain why they are good choices for a party. (5 marks)

6. Translate this sentence into English: 'Hoy es viernes.' (5 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Rosa the parrot doing her favorite activity on 'viernes'. Label your drawing with the word 'viernes'.
