

Rosa's Family Portrait Activity

Learning objective: To identify and label members of the family using Spanish vocabulary.

Rosa the parrot wants to share her family tree with you! Follow the drawing prompt to create your own family scene, then use the labels from the word bank to identify the people in your drawing.

Draw: Draw a large, happy family scene in the center of your page. Include at least four different family members doing something together, such as eating a meal, playing a game in the park, or sitting on a sofa. Use a colorful, bright style. Once your scene is drawn, draw a neat line from each person to the edge of the paper and write the correct Spanish label from the word bank.



Label words: la madre (mother) · el padre (father) · el hermano (brother) · la hermana (sister) · el abuelo (grandfather) · la abuela (grandmother)

Steps:

1. Choose three people from your drawing. Write their Spanish label and one English sentence about what they are doing in your picture.
2. If you wanted to say 'My family' in Spanish, how would you write it? (Hint: Use 'Mi' for 'My').
