

La Familia: Meet Rosa's Family!

Join Rosa the parrot and learn how to introduce your family in Spanish!

- To say 'my mother', we use the phrase 'mi madre'.
- To say 'my father', we use the phrase 'mi padre'.
- If you have a sister, you say 'mi hermana'.
- If you have a brother, you say 'mi hermano'.
- Grandparents are 'los abuelos'.

Did you know? Did you know? In Spanish, words for family members change depending on whether they are masculine or feminine. We use 'el' for masculine nouns and 'la' for feminine nouns. It is like a secret code for your family tree!
