

Rosa's Spanish Greetings Adventure

Learning objective: To learn and apply common Spanish greetings and basic introductions suitable for Grade 3.

Help Rosa the parrot learn her Spanish! Read the word bank carefully and use the Spanish phrases to complete the exercises below.

Word bank: Hola - Hello · Buenos días - Good morning · Buenas tardes - Good afternoon · Buenas noches - Good night · ¿Cómo estás? - How are you? · Me llamo... - My name is... · Adiós - Goodbye · Por favor - Please · Gracias - Thank you

1. Rosa meets a friend in the morning. What is the most polite way for her to say 'Good morning' and ask 'How are you?' in Spanish? (2 marks)

2. If you are introducing yourself to a new friend, which phrase from the word bank would you use to say your name? Write a full sentence using your own name. (2 marks)

3. Match the English phrases to the correct Spanish translations: 1) Thank you, 2) Goodbye, 3) Good night. (3 marks)

4. Imagine it is 4:00 PM. Which greeting would you choose: 'Buenos días' or 'Buenas tardes'? Explain why. (2 marks)

5. Rosa wants to ask for a snack politely. Which word from the bank should she add to her request? (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picture of Rosa the parrot having a tea party with her friends. Label the speech bubble for Rosa with a Spanish greeting from the word bank.



Extension challenge: Write a short dialogue between two characters meeting in the park. Include a greeting, an introduction of names, a question about how they are feeling, and a goodbye.
