

Spanish Hobbies with Rosa the Parrot

Learning objective: To learn and use Spanish vocabulary for hobbies and express preferences using 'me gusta' (I like) and 'no me gusta' (I do not like).

Read the Spanish phrases carefully and use the word bank to help you answer the questions about hobbies. Remember to use full sentences where asked.

Word bank: leer (to read) · jugar al fútbol (to play football) · nadar (to swim) · dibujar (to draw) · escuchar música (to listen to music) · me gusta (I like) · no me gusta (I do not like)

1. Rosa says, 'Me gusta leer.' Translate this sentence into English. (1 mark)

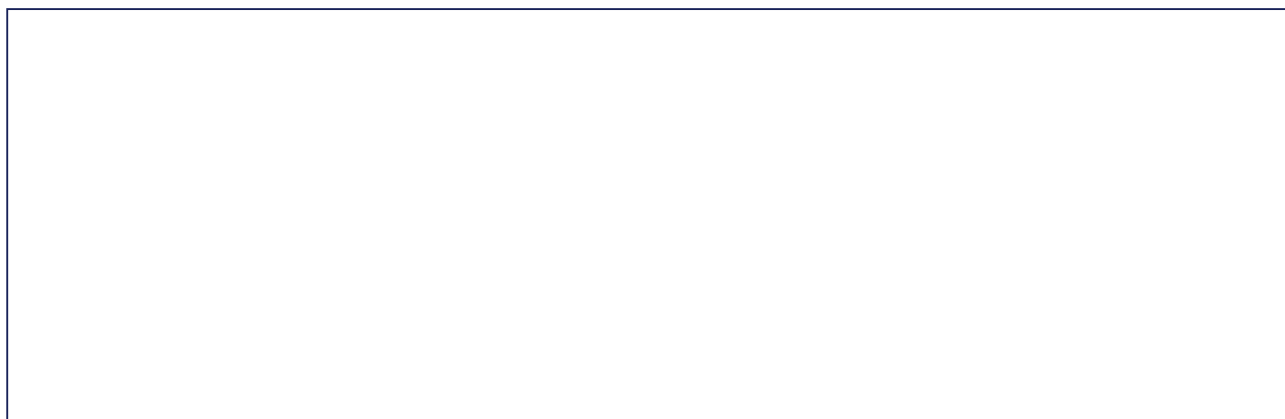
2. If you do not like to swim, how would you write that in Spanish using the word bank? (1 mark)

3. Match the hobby to the Spanish phrase by writing the correct hobby next to the activity: 1. Dibujar, 2. Jugar al fútbol, 3. Escuchar música. (3 marks)

4. Write a sentence in Spanish explaining one hobby you like and one hobby you do not like. (2 marks)

5. Finn the dolphin loves to swim. Write a sentence in Spanish that Rosa would say to describe Finn's hobby. (2 marks)
