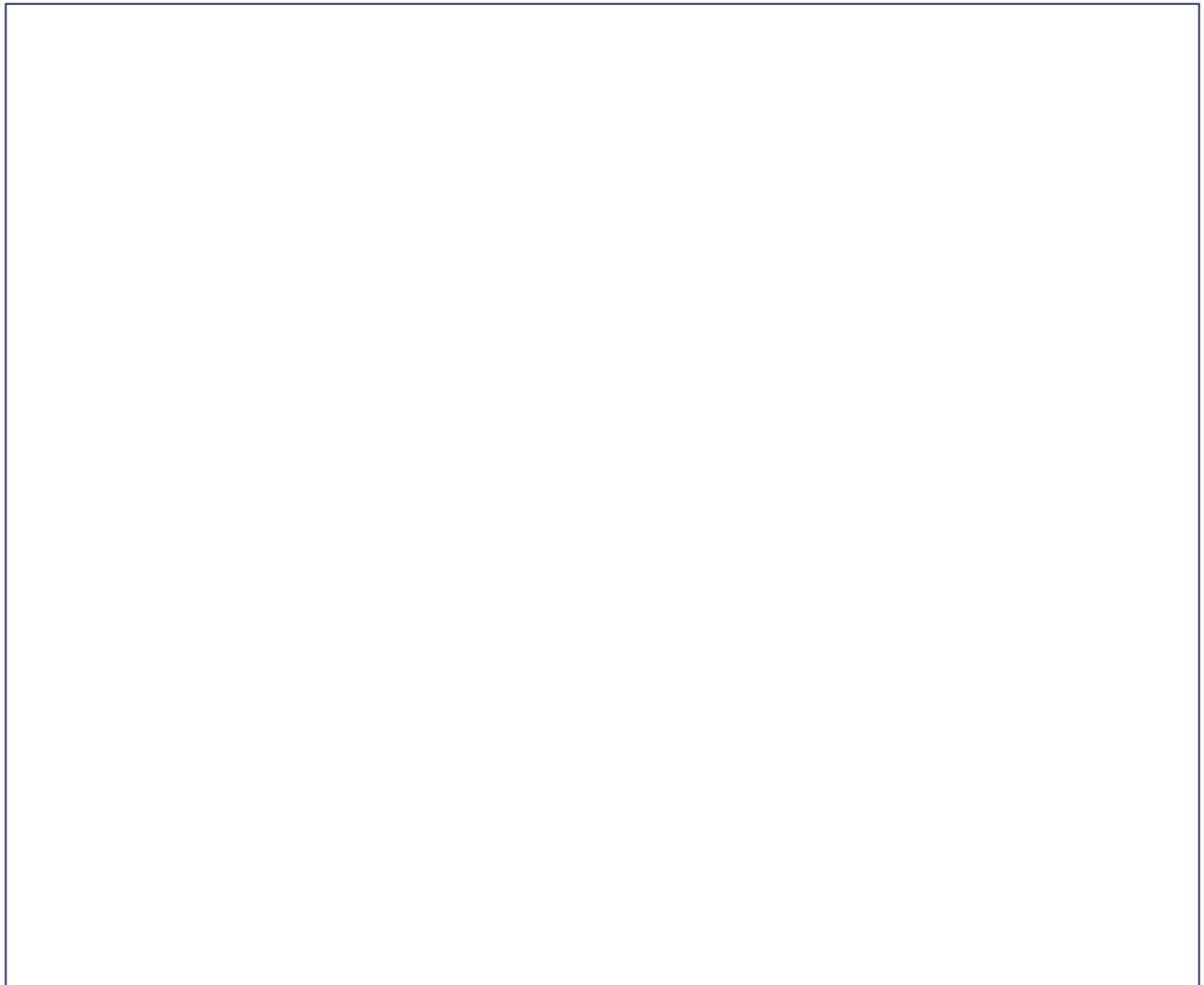


Rosa's Spanish Number Market

Learning objective: To identify and use Spanish numbers from 1 to 20 within a creative context.

Rosa the parrot has opened a fruit stall at the market! Help her label her items by drawing them and writing the correct Spanish number word next to each group. Use the word bank provided.

Draw: Draw a sunny market scene. Include a wooden stall with a sign that says 'Rosa's Fruit'. On the stall, draw clusters of fruit: 5 apples, 10 oranges, 12 pears, 15 bananas, and 20 small grapes. Ensure there is enough space around each group of fruit to write the Spanish number word clearly in your neatest handwriting. Add a colorful parrot sitting on the roof of the stall.



Label words: uno (1) · cinco (5) · diez (10) · doce (12) · quince (15) · veinte (20)

Steps:

1. Draw 5 apples in the basket. Label the basket with the correct Spanish word from the word bank.
2. Rosa has 10 oranges. Draw the oranges and write the Spanish word for 10 next to them.
3. If Rosa sells 1 apple, how many are left? Write the answer as a number and then in Spanish.
4. Draw 20 grapes on a vine. Label the bunch with the Spanish word for 20.
5. Rosa wants to sell 15 bananas. Draw the bananas and label them with the correct Spanish word.
