

Rosa's Spanish School Diary: Mi Escuela

Learning objective: To use Spanish vocabulary to describe school subjects, facilities, and personal preferences.

Hola! Rosa the parrot wants to hear all about your school day. Use your Spanish vocabulary to fill in the sections below. Remember to use the word bank to help you with your spelling. Write neatly and try to include a full sentence for each answer.

Word bank: la clase de matemáticas (math) · la clase de arte (art) · la clase de educación física (PE) · la biblioteca (library) · el patio (playground) · me gusta (I like) · no me gusta (I don't like) · mi asignatura favorita es... (my favorite subject is...) · mi escuela es... (my school is...)

1. Describe your school in Spanish: Tell me what your school is like using the phrase 'Mi escuela es...' and one adjective (e.g., grande/small, divertida/fun). (2 marks)

2. My favorite subject: State what your favorite subject is using 'Mi asignatura favorita es...' and explain why you enjoy it. (2 marks)

3. School facilities: Rosa loves to explore! Write down two places in your school (e.g., the library or the playground) using the Spanish words provided. (2 marks)

4. Likes and dislikes: Write one sentence about a subject you like ('Me gusta...') and one sentence about a subject you find tricky ('No me gusta...'). (2 marks)

5. Summary: If you could add one new thing to our school, what would it be? Write your answer in English or Spanish. (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Can you write a short dialogue between you and Rosa? Imagine she asks you '¿Qué te gusta hacer en el recreo?' (What do you like to do at break time?) and write your response in Spanish.
