Learning objective: To practice telling the time in Spanish and describing daily activities using the verb 'ser' for time.

Join Rosa the parrot as she plans her day! Fill in the boxes below to describe what time Rosa does her favorite activities. Remember to use 'Es la una...' for 1 o'clock and 'Son las...' for all other hours. Add the minutes using 'y' (and) or 'menos' (to) to complete your sentences.

3. In the afternoon, Rosa reads a book. Write a sentence describing an activity she does at 3:15 (Son las tres y cuarto). (3 marks)

4. Rosa eats a snack at 4:30. How would you write this time in Spanish? (2 marks)

5. Rosa goes to sleep at 8:45 (quarter to nine). Write the Spanish phrase for this time. (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Challenge: Can you write three sentences about your own school day using Spanish time phrases? Try to include one activity that happens at 'y media' (half past).
