

## Zara's Masterclass: The Art of Collage

*Did you know? Did you know? The term 'collage' comes from the French word 'coller', which literally means 'to glue'. Many artists, including famous pioneers in the early 20th century, used collage to show that art doesn't always need to be painted—it can be built from the world around us!*
