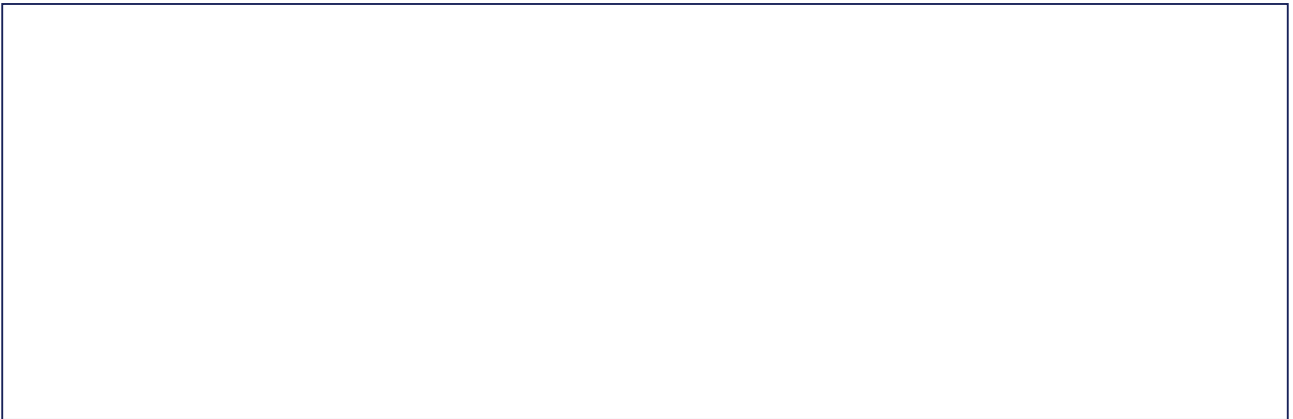
7. 7. True or False: Picasso experimented with 'collage', which involves sticking different materials like newspaper onto a canvas. (1 mark)
