

Zara the Zebra's Adjective Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and use adjectives to describe nouns in a simple sentence.

Look at the picture of Zara the Zebra. Think of words that describe how things look, feel, or smell. Colour the picture and write your own adjectives to describe the items below.

Colour this: A large, clear line-art drawing of Zara the Zebra standing in a garden. Zara is smiling and holding a large, single sunflower. Zara has clear, bold stripes. Behind Zara, there is a large, round sun in the sky and two fluffy clouds. In the grass at her feet, there are three different shaped leaves and a small, round ladybird. The lines should be thick and easy for 3-5 year olds to colour within.



Steps:

1. Label the stripes on Zara. Use a describing word like 'wavy' or 'dark'.
2. Label the flower Zara is holding. Use a describing word like 'pretty' or 'bright'.
