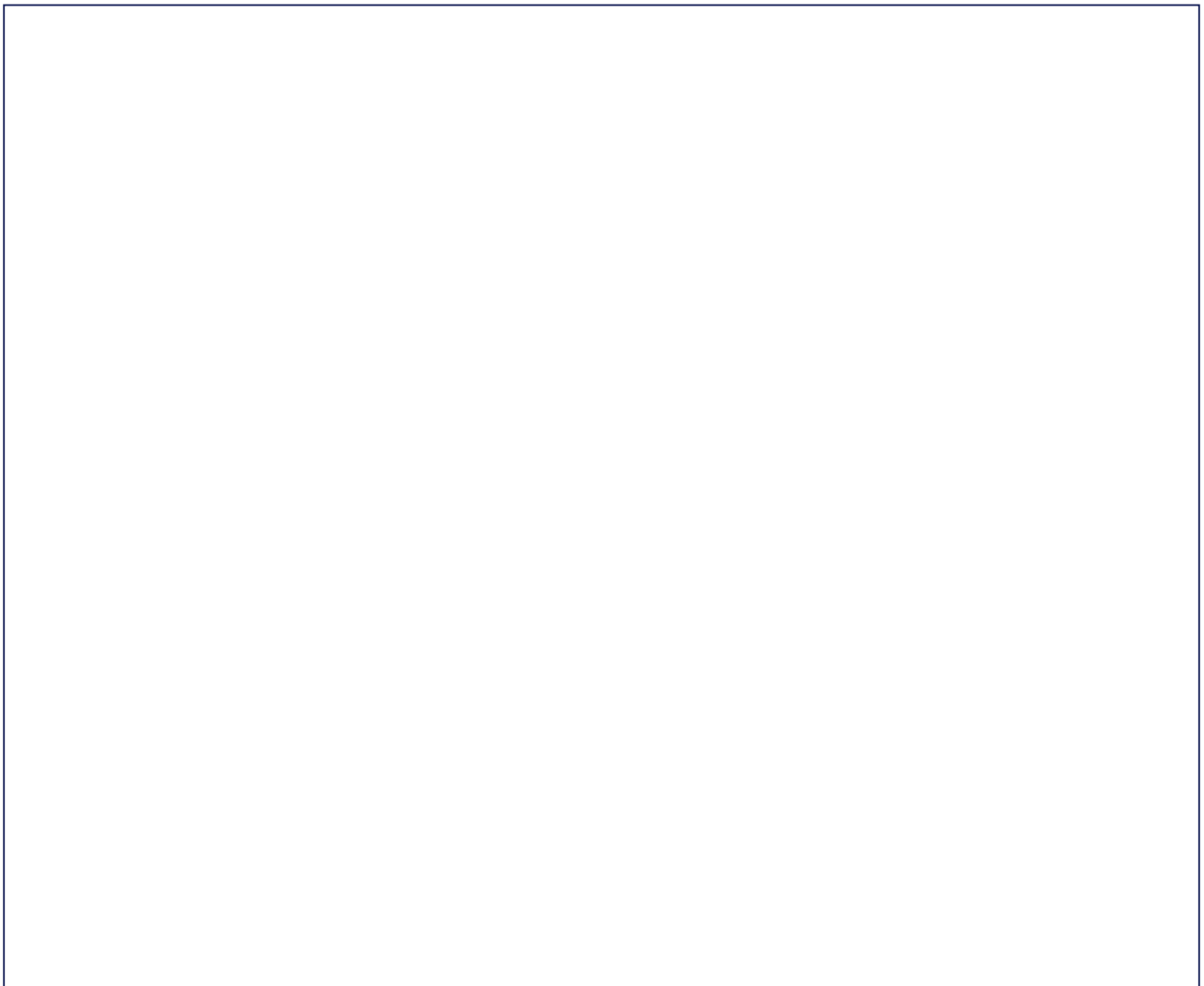


Max's Magnificent Garden

Learning objective: To use adjectives to describe objects and animals in a drawing.

Max the monkey is busy exploring a garden! Help him describe what he sees by drawing the items below and adding labels using the word bank to describe them.

Draw: Draw a sunny garden scene. Include Max the monkey standing in the middle. Add a large tree, a patch of colourful flowers, a small animal (like a rabbit or a beetle) hiding in the grass, and a stone on the path. Use the word bank to add descriptive labels to your drawing with arrows pointing to the items.



Label words: spiky · fluffy · shiny · huge · tiny · bright · soft · bumpy

Steps:

1. Draw a tree in the garden. Label it using one adjective from the word bank.
2. Draw a small animal hiding in the grass. What does it look like? Write your description.
3. Draw a flower. Which adjective from the list best describes how it looks?
4. Max found a stone. Draw the stone and label it with an adjective.
5. Write a sentence using one of the adjectives to describe the whole garden scene.
