

Adjective Adventures with Pip the Caterpillar

Learning objective: To use adjectives to describe nouns in a simple setting.

Pip the caterpillar is exploring a magical forest. Look at the word bank for ideas, then answer the questions to build your own story. Use describing words to tell us what Pip can see!

Pip the caterpillar crawled slowly onto a large, emerald leaf to start his morning journey.

Word bank: bright · fuzzy · shiny · giant · tiny · colourful · soft · green · and · but

1. Pip saw a flower near the path. What does the flower look like? Start your sentence with: The flower was... (2 marks)

2. Pip met a beetle on a rock. Can you describe the beetle? Start your sentence with: He saw a beetle that was... (2 marks)

3. The sun is shining in the sky. What colour is the sky today? Start your sentence with: The sky looked... (2 marks)

4. Pip found a stone. How does the stone feel to touch? Start your sentence with: The stone felt... (2 marks)

5. How is Pip feeling about his walk? Start your sentence with: Pip felt... (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Can you choose one of your sentences and add a second adjective? For example, instead of 'the red flower', try 'the red, sparkly flower'.
