

Max's Magnificent Market Maths

Learning objective: To identify and use adjectives to describe nouns in a creative context.

Max the monkey is helping at the local market. He needs to describe the items he is selling to make them sound special. Look at the word bank of adjectives and choose the best one to describe each item in the questions. You may use an adjective more than once if you need to!

Word bank: sparkly · juicy · crunchy · fluffy · gigantic · smooth · sweet · bright

1. Max has a basket of apples. Write a sentence using an adjective from the bank to describe the apples. (2 marks)

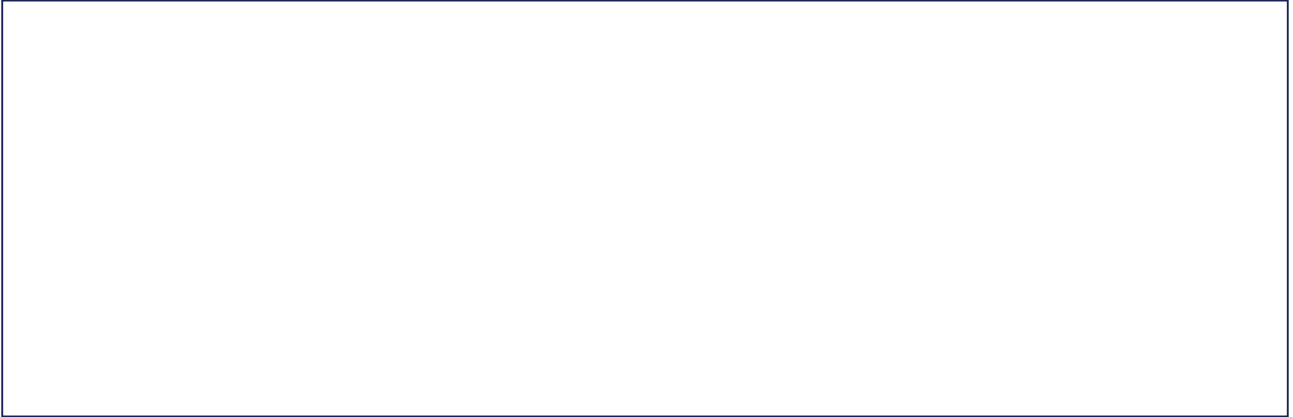
2. There is a teddy bear for sale at the stall. Which adjective best describes how it feels to touch? (2 marks)

3. Max is selling a watermelon that is very big. Which adjective from the bank should he use? (2 marks)

4. Choose a noun from the market (like a scarf, a peach, or a bag) and write a phrase using one adjective and one noun. (2 marks)

5. Why do you think Max uses adjectives when talking to customers? Explain your idea. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Max the monkey standing at his market stall. Label two of the items you have drawn using an adjective and a noun (e.g., 'a shiny apple').



Extension challenge: Can you think of two more adjectives that are not in the word bank to describe a bunch of yellow bananas?
