

Adjective Explorers with Pip the Bookworm

Learning objective: To identify, understand, and use adjectives to describe nouns effectively.

Read the front of the flashcard to see the task or question. Flip it over (or read the answer) to check if you have identified the correct adjective or description. Practise using these words in your own sentences.

What is an adjective?	Find the adjective: The fluffy caterpillar ate a leaf.
An adjective is a word that describes a noun (a person, place, or thing).	Fluffy.
Add an adjective: The ____ owl looked at the moon.	Find the adjective: Max the monkey climbed the tall tree.
Examples include: wise, bright, nocturnal, or silent.	Tall.
Turn this into a descriptive sentence: The elephant walked.	Find the adjective: Zara painted a beautiful picture.
Example: The enormous, grey elephant walked slowly.	Beautiful.
Which word is the adjective? 'Cold' or 'Run'?	Find the adjective: Finn saw a shimmering blue sea.
Cold.	Shimmering, blue.
Add an adjective: Bea the bee landed on a ____ flower.	Find the adjective: Leo wrote a brave poem.
Examples include: colourful, fragrant, delicate, or bright.	Brave.
Can an adjective describe a colour? Give an example.	Find the adjective: Kit solved a clever puzzle.
Yes! Examples include: golden, emerald, crimson, or navy.	Clever.
