Learning objective: To identify and use adverbs to describe how an action is performed.

Read the front of each card to learn about adverbs. Max the Monkey uses adverbs to explain how he completes his maths puzzles! Use these cards to practise spotting the words that describe verbs.

What is an adverb?

An adverb is a word that describes a verb (an action).

Max climbed the tree quickly. Which word is the adverb?

quickly

Most adverbs end in which two letters?

-ly

Ellie the elephant walked slowly. What is the verb?

walked

Zara the zebra painted happily. Which word is the adverb?

happily

Pip the caterpillar read the book carefully. What does 'carefully' tell us?

It tells us how Pip read the book.
