Learning objective: To recognise and celebrate the achievements of significant individuals in history during Black History Month.

Look at the picture of Ellie the Elephant learning about history. Colour in the picture and talk to your grown-up about the brave people we are learning about today.

Colour this: A large, friendly elephant named Ellie wearing a pair of round spectacles, sitting on a comfy rug. She is holding an open, illustrated storybook in her trunk. On the wall behind her, there are simple outlines of a large shining star and a scroll representing history.
