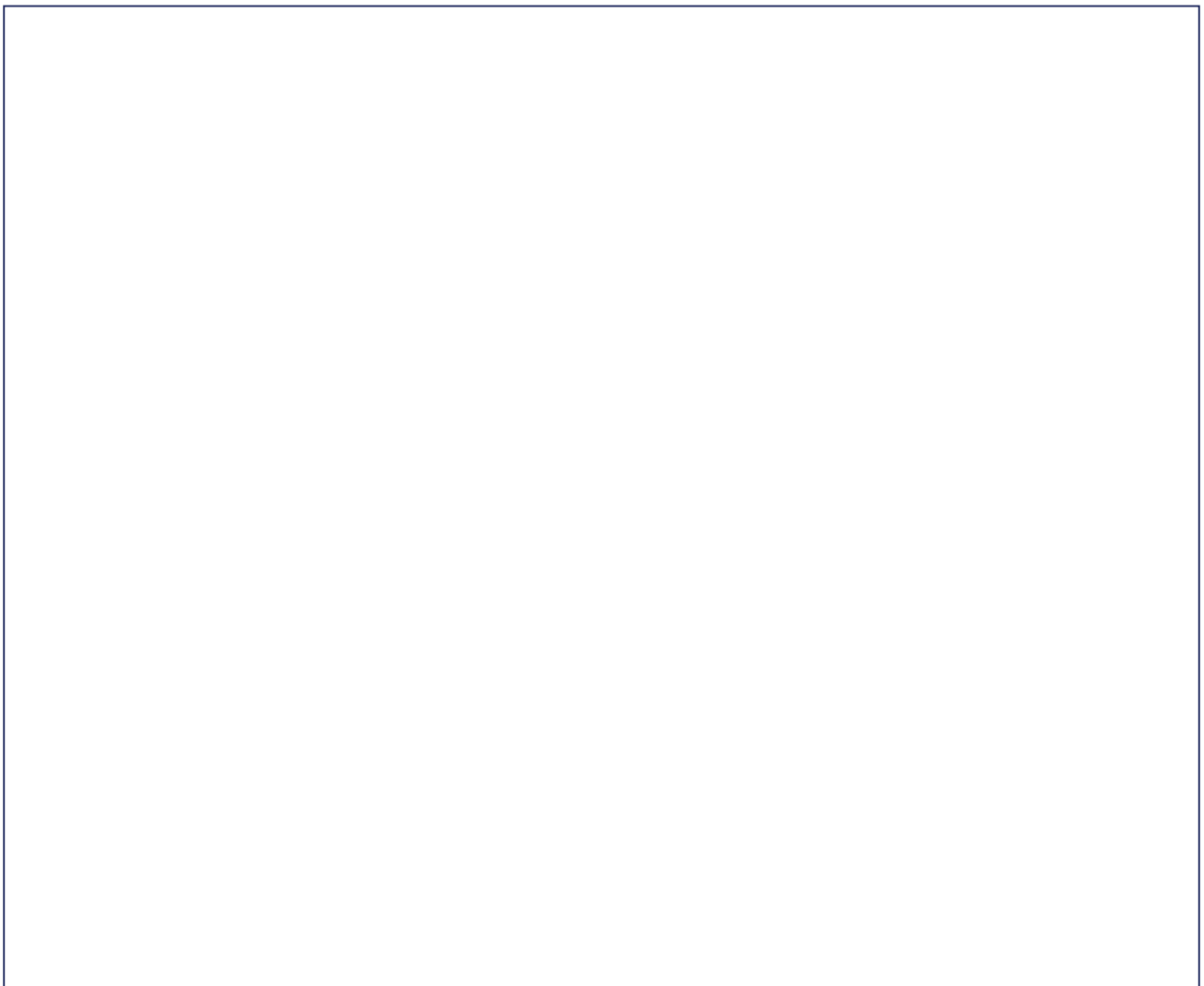


Celebrating Remarkable People

Learning objective: To identify and celebrate the achievements of significant individuals in Black history through drawing and labelling.

Today, we are going to learn about heroes who changed the world! Look at the portraits of important people in history. Choose one person who inspires you, draw them in the space provided, and add labels to show why they are special.

Draw: In the large empty box, draw a portrait of a significant person from Black history. Use bright colours to show their personality. Around the portrait, draw small pictures of things they loved or things they achieved. If you draw an inventor, draw their invention next to them. If you draw a leader, draw them standing tall. Use clear lines and labels from the word bank to point to your drawing.



Label words: brave · leader · kind · inventor · strong · hero · teacher · scientist

Steps:

1. Write the name of the person you have chosen to draw.
2. Which word from the word bank best describes your person? Why?
3. Label your drawing with at least two adjectives from the word bank.
4. Draw one item in your picture that represents something the person achieved (e.g., a book, a microphone,

or a medal).

5. If you could ask this person one question, what would it be?
