Use the prompts below to write about a person you have learned about during Black History Month. Remember to use capital letters for names and full stops at the end of your sentences.

4. How do they make you feel? Start your sentence with: 'Learning about them makes me feel...' (2 marks)

5. Can you draw a picture of your chosen person in the box below? Add a label to your drawing. (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Can you write one more sentence using the word 'because' to explain what you would like to do to help others in the future?
