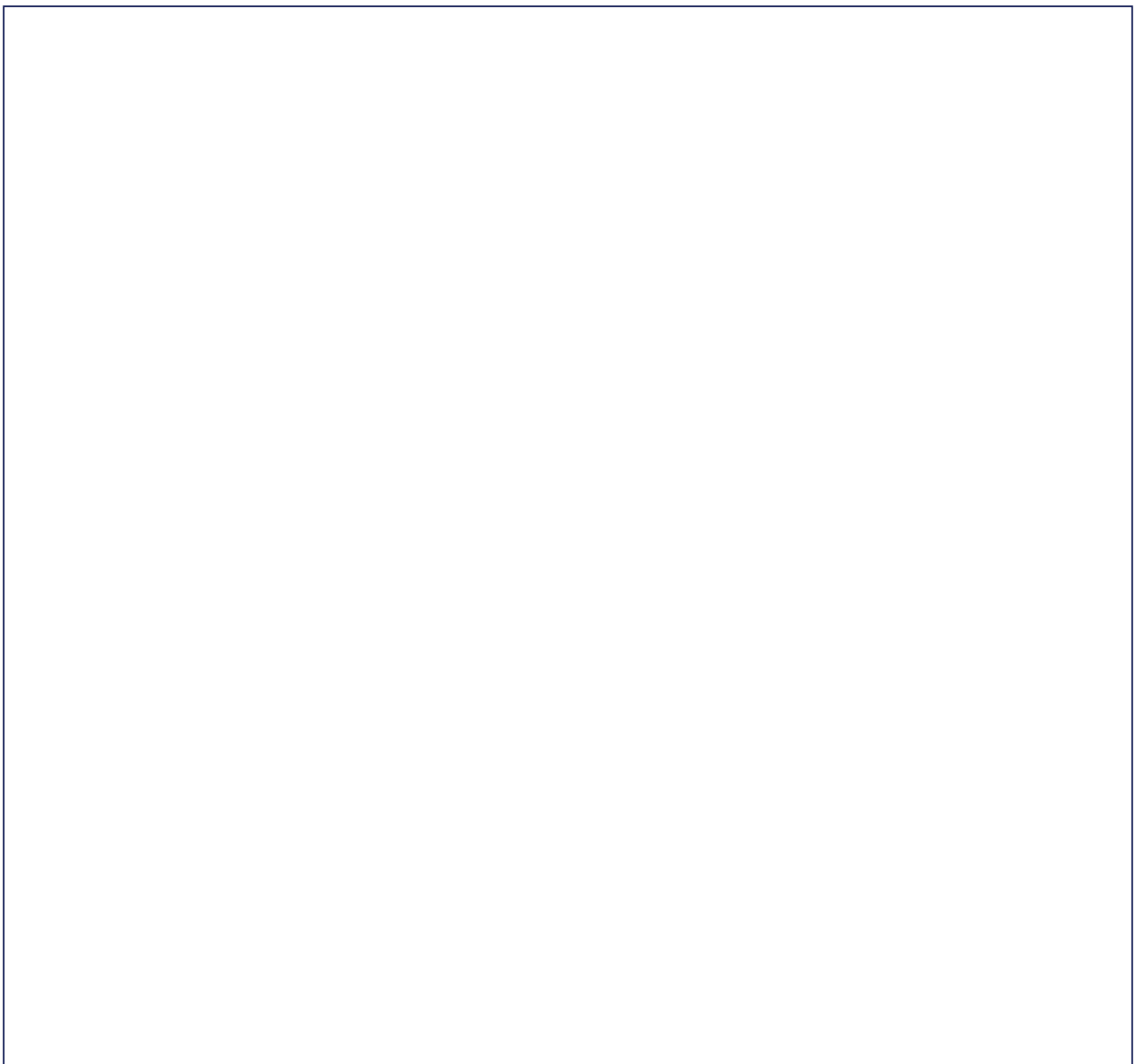


Celebrating Pioneers: Black History Month

Learning objective: To learn about the achievements of influential Black figures and practice descriptive writing through labelling.

Read the facts about these inspiring people, colour in the scene, and complete the labels to show what you have learned about their achievements.
