

A Night of Sparkles: My Bonfire Night Fact-File

Learning objective: To write a non-fiction fact-file about Bonfire Night using capital letters, full stops, and descriptive adjectives.

Help Nova the owl learn about Bonfire Night! Use this fact-file to write down what you know about the celebration. Remember to use your best handwriting, capital letters at the start of sentences, and full stops at the end. Use the word bank to help you with your spelling.

1. What does a bonfire look like? Describe the flames and the heat. (2 marks)

2. Write down two adjectives to describe how the fireworks look in the night sky. (2 marks)

3. What special treats do people eat on Bonfire Night? Describe your favourite one. (2 marks)

4. Why must we always stay safe when near a fire or a sparkler? (2 marks)

5. If you could invent a new firework, what colour would it be and what shape would it make? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Write a short poem about the sound fireworks make. Can you include words like 'whizz', 'pop', and 'bang'?
