Learning objective: To write descriptive sentences about Bonfire Night using adjectives and conjunctions.

Read the opening sentence. Use the prompts below to write your own story about a special evening of fireworks. Remember to use capital letters and full stops.

1. What did the fireworks look like? Start your sentence with: The fireworks looked like... (2 marks)

2. What sounds did you hear? Start your sentence with: I could hear... (2 marks)

3. How did the air feel? Start your sentence with: The air felt... (2 marks)

4. What was your favourite part of the night? Start your sentence with: My favourite part was... (2 marks)

5. How did you feel watching the show? Start your sentence with: I felt... (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Ask Nova the owl: Can you write one more sentence using the word 'because' to explain why the fireworks were so exciting?
