

A Sparkly Night with Nova and Leo

Learning objective: To use descriptive adjectives and time-related conjunctions to write about the sights and sounds of Bonfire Night.

Read the questions carefully and use your best handwriting. Remember to use capital letters and full stops for your sentences.

Nova the owl and Leo the lion are watching the night sky. They see bright colours and hear loud noises. They are thinking about how to describe the magic of the evening.

Word bank: sparkling · crackling · whizzing · flickering · after · suddenly · vibrant · dazzling

1. Nova wants to describe the fire. Write a sentence using an adjective from the word bank to describe the flames. (2 marks)

2. Leo heard a loud 'pop' in the sky. Write a sentence using the word 'suddenly' to explain what happened next. (2 marks)

3. Think of two adjectives to describe the colours of a firework. Write them here. (2 marks)

4. If a pack of sparklers costs £2 and a box of safety goggles costs £3, how much would you spend in total? (2 marks)

5. Why is it important to stay behind the safety fence during a bonfire display? Give one reason. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Nova the owl and Leo the lion watching fireworks. Make sure to draw vibrant patterns in the sky and include a safety fence in the background.



Extension challenge: Write a short poem about the night sky, using at least two of the words from the word bank to make your description extra special.
